TAX COLLECTION ACTION COMMITTEE May 29, 2013

The May 29, 2013 special meeting of the Tax Collector Action Committee was called to order at 4:00 p.m. The following members were present. Sharon Scinto, Jack Kiley, Jim Hliva, First Selectman George Temple and Kevin Condon.

There was nothing new to report on ongoing litigation with JJTM and litigation on the outstanding accounts.

George Temple told Attorney Condon that he wanted to proceed with the deposition of the former Tax Collector Karen Guillet. Kevin stated that it is in the works and that the bonding company is now involved.

Jim Hliva and Jack Kiley met to review the open accounts. The accounts were sorted to have accounts that submitted proof presented to the Committee and after verified to be sent to the Board of Selectmen for approval. Fifty nine accounts were presented to the Committee showing that people had paid and their method of proof was an Escrow Statement from the bank showing that the accounts had been paid by the bank and the homeowners mortgage escrow account was charged. The total for the 59 accounts was \$126,224.20. Jim Hliva made a motion to approve the list and forward it to the Board of Selectmen for approval. Second by Jack Kiley. Motion passed unanimously. Next 35 accounts were presented to the committee showing that the people had paid their taxes and the method of proof was a receipt from the Tax Collector. The total for the 35 accounts was \$61,712.09. Jim Hliva made a motion to approve the list and forward it to the Board of Selectmen for approval. Second by George Temple. Motion passed unanimously.

Jack Kiley made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Jim Hliva. The meeting was adjourned at 4:55 p.m.
