7) New Business

(a) approve transfer 2015-2016 (Library)

Dawn Higginson, the Oxford Librarian, was present to discuss the transfer requests. The transfers are coming from the 2015-2016 budget. The transfers were requested in April 2015, but apparently paperwork was not received. The transfers were resubmitted in June 2015. Ms. Higginson began a detailed explanation behind the departmental transfer requests. Mr. Kelly asked why the significant difference in the budgeted amount for supplies, what was the driving factor. He noticed that Ms. Higginson was taking from different lines to cover expenses. Mr. Hliva noted that the First Selectman, George Temple, would be meeting with the Library Board of Directors to discuss the problem.

Mr. Kelly asked what brought the items into the Library which caused the expenditures. Ms. Higginson said she had ordered materials for summer reading program and updated collection of non-fiction to replace outdated materials. There was no expectation to do this at the 2014 budget preparation.

Ms. Ferrillo asked Ms. Higginson how often do bills come in and how often does she pay the bills. Ms. Higginson said she asks Mr. Hliva for an updated ledger because she does not have access on her computer. She tries to process bills as they come in.

Mr. Kelly asked with regard to Item #12-Civic Activities (programs). Are these additional programs not budgeted. Ms. Ferrillo proceeded to make the explanation of staying inside the parameters of a budgeted amount. Because of this item, Wages-Part-time is depleted. Ms. Arpin asked how far in advance the summer program is planned.

Mr. Kiley noted that the next budget numbers will be skewed. Mr. Kelly gave Ms. Higginson a very detailed explanation as to how the budget process works, i.e. now that she has transferred from line items it will lower her budget for next year.

Mr. Kiley made a Motion to approve transfer requests for Items #10 (\$146.00), 11 (\$1,798.73), 12 (\$1,900.00), and 13 (\$3,781.69). Mr. DeBisschop seconded the Motion. A vote is taken.

(e) Request from Tetlak Park Committee to use contingency for sod and bleachers

Glen Schumitz, 197 Freeman Road, Oxford, CT, Chairman of the Tetlak Park Committee, is present to request transfer from contingency. Mr. Schumitz gave the Board of Finance a brief update on the status of the project at Tetlak Park. He is also requesting \$30,000.00 from Contingency for sod and \$12,000.00 for bleachers. He told the BOF members that the contractor has advised that because of the current weather, sod would be a better option, allowing use of the field earlier next year. Seeding might be too hard to take because of the lack of rain this summer. Seeding is scheduled to begin in mid-October.

Mr. Kiley discussed the use of the Contingency is not for "add-ons". Ms. Ferrillo asked what the plan is if there is not enough water to maintain either seed or sod. Vaz, who is the contractor hired to complete the project, gave an alternative bid of \$30,000.00 for sod.

Mr. Schumitz gave a detailed explanation of the need for the request for sod and bleachers. The original plan was for seed; there was no plan for bleachers. The expectation for bleachers is that they would be acquired through various fundraisers.

After lengthy discussion among Ms. Ferrillo, Mr. Kiley, Mr. Kelly and Mr. Schumitz, a Motion was made by Ms. Ferrillo to deny the request for \$30,000 for sod and \$12,000 for bleachers. Mr. Kelly seconded the Motion. A vote was taken.

- 1. Fire Marshal: Mr. Kelly asked why this is happening within the Department. Mr. Hliva responded the increases are due to raises approved by Selectmen. Fire Marshal's wages are increased because of open burning wages. Open burning was removed last year so no position exists. Mr. Kelly asks where is the funding. A detailed explanation among the BOF ensued regarding the increased salary. Ms. Flach brought up the issue of insurance and another lengthy discussion ensued.

Mr. Hliva explained what will happen if the wage increase is not approved by Board of Finance. The account on books will be overdrawn and auditors will question and this would be a footnote in the audit.

> Mr. Kiley suggested making a Motion to only approve 2.5% of Fire Marshal's base pay and reduce the amount of transfer from Heating Line item 5325-625 to be reduced by same amount. Mr. Kiley rescinded his original Motion which had been seconded by Mr. DeBisschop
