1. Hire Parks & Recreation Summer Employee

There is a clause in the contract that when hired, they do have to stay two years. We will be getting additional bills. Police overtime is not a bargain with State troopers, but Oxford cannot provide a dispatch system, which would cost over \$1 million. It is very hard to get police since there is no advancement opportunity in Oxford. We are also loosing another Police officer in June. Jeff Haney stated we have to pay it now, but we need to monitor it. Dave McKane stated we could have two police officers if we didn't have to pay overtime.
