I.W.E. Officer A. Ferrillo stated: We received a letter from Mr. Sippin for a request for an extension of his permit. We are not able to extend another 5 year extension because per the Public Act 11-5 for the Connecticut State Statutes states we are not to exceed 14 years. We can extend him to 2018 and we will send him a letter for that.

I.W.E. Officer A. Ferrillo replied: The permit is for a road and sewer connection to the bridle path, which has not been done yet.
