

- 1. Tax Abatement for retired volunteer FF No movement.
- 2. <u>R44 Truck Committee</u> May 15, 2024 is tentative preconstruction date. November 2024 is tentative build date.
- 3. Officers Brush fire training set for 2/23/23 at 7 p.m. at each station.
- 4. <u>Radios</u> Mobile Radios have been ordered. We are working with the phone company on the upgrade to fiber optics lines.
- 5. <u>Emergency Contact List</u> No movement on request for contact information for trailer park to be forwarded to dispatch center.
- 6. <u>Haynes Building/Quarry Walk</u> 500 Boulder Pass is approximately half way completed. Walk through set up for 2/28/23 (February monthly drill).
- 7. <u>High Rise Paks/Quarry Walk</u> High Rise Paks have been received. Thanks to Haynes Construction for funding. Photo will be done on 2/28/23.
- 8. <u>Burn Trailer</u> Arrangements to use burn trailer will be set up.
- 9. <u>AFG Grant</u> Replacement of CFC compressor needed and filling station for the building. Grant was submitted on 2/10/23.
- 10. <u>Safer Grant</u> Purchase of LED Sign for use at CFC to give information about OFD events, weather conditions and the like. Sign would also be used to advertise for volunteers needed at OFD and Oxford Ambulance which will qualify us for the grant. Waiting for grant to open. Helen Leung will write the grant.

- 11. <u>LoCIP</u>—Funding approved for RFC stairs and concrete work at RFC and for roof at CFC. Bid to be obtained. New Town Facility Manager, George Renzoni, will work on this.
- 12. <u>Capital Plan FY 2023/24</u> Motion to approve the proposed FY23/24 Capital budget and Long Term Capital Plan revised 1/11/23 made by AC Gramigna. Second by AC Hellauer. Motion passed unanimously.
- 13. <u>General Fund Budget FY 2023/24</u> Motion to approve the proposed FY23/24 operating budget made by AC Gramigna. Second by AC Hellauer. Motion passed unanimously.

New Business

- 1. <u>Chief of Department 2023</u> Motion made by AC Hellauer to nominate Scott Pelletier as Chief of Department for 2023. Dan Gramigna will remain an Assistant Chief (Car 2) and Edwin Hellauer will remain an Assistant Chief (Car 3). Second by AC Gramigna. Motion passed unanimously.
- 2. <u>Valley Fire Chiefs Regional Training School</u> Motion made by AC Gramigna to nominate Edwin Hellauer as Oxford's Representative for 2023 on Valley Fire Chiefs Regional Training School Board. Second by Chief Pelletier. Motion passed.
- 3. <u>Standard Nozzle</u> Mike McGee was asked to take the lead and work with 2nd Lieutenants to do evaluation and make a choice for a standard nozzle.

Remarks for the Good of the Department – Chief Pelletier thanked all who attended the 2/3/23 structure fire. It was a long, extremely cold, wet evening and all who attended did a great job. He thanked EMS crew who helped warm firefighters, and wives and girlfriends who brought drinks and food. Public Works did a great job to keep the roads safe. Excellent job done by all. A review meeting of the incident is set for 2/15/23 at 7 pm at QFC. AC Hellauer spoke about the frozen hydrants and the water company should be checking and maintaining them on a regular basis. Chief Pelletier will speak to them. Keep up the good work, stay hydrated and stay safe.

<u>Adjournment</u> – AC Gramigna moved to adjourn the meeting at 8:07 p.m. Second by AC Hellauer. Motion passed unanimously.
