

Unfinished Business

- 1. <u>Tax Abatement for retired volunteer FF</u> Committee membership reviewed. Committee will also work on possibilities for Tax Abatement for FF who do not own real estate. OFC member joined the committee. Meeting will be held in August.
- 2. R44 Truck Committee 5/15/24 is tentative preconstruction date. November 2024 is tentative build date.
- 3. Officers Next meeting set for 9/28/23 at CFC.
- 4. Radios Programming for new mobile radio discussed. All fiber and hardware from Frontier was installed at all locations. Still waiting for two pieces of equipment for our side. Installation will begin with Chiefs cars (installed at shop).
- 5. <u>Burn Trailer</u> Arrangements will be made for use of burn trailer for training in fall.
- 6. AFG Grant Grant submitted on 2/10/23 for CFC compressor and filling station.

- 7. <u>LoCIP</u> Concrete work at RFC is completed and it looks good. Roof for CFC funding from LoCIP is not enough. George Renzoni will talk to the Grant Writer to request additional funds from LoCIP.
- 8. <u>LED Sign</u> ARPA fund committee want the sign to be placed where the community sign is currently located. Wifi does not reach that location from either CFC or the Town annex building. There is concern that the initial purpose of the sign will be lost. Board of Selectmen will discuss the matter.
- 9. Quarry Coffee Advertisement was found for a car show to be held on the weekend of 6/17/23 to benefit Oxford Fire Department. Quarry Coffee made no contact with OFD. Letter was sent asking them to contact Chief Pelletier to discuss the matter.
