

- 9. <u>Tax Abatement</u> Proposed policy change was approved at Board of Selectmen meeting on 7/21/21.
- 10. <u>Fireworks</u> Set for 8/27/21 (7/2/21 fireworks were cancelled due to rain). QFC will sell fried dough and B55 is needed for fireworks.
- 11. Hose Testing Set for 8/25/21at Quaker Farms School.
- 12. <u>Fire Hydrant Field Inspection</u> Rowland Farms and Trailer Park have been inspected. Additional fire hydrants will be added. This is being addressed by the water company.

- 1. <u>Haynes Touch-A-Truck</u> BH Care planned the event and set it for 8/14/21 from 10:30 am to 2:30 pm. We need to bring apparatus to the event.

Motion made by AC Gramigna moved to approve the request from CFC to bring R44 and TK46 to the Beacon Falls parade on 10/16/21. Second by AC Downs. Motion passed unanimously.
