Regular Meeting Minutes

June 3, 2013

CALL TO ORDER

Todd Romagna called the meeting to order at 7:15 PM.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

ROLL CALL

Present: Todd Romagna, Dawn Krassner, Nona Baker, Alana Flach, Mark Adams and Bryan Nesteriak.

Site Work

- TFI put in the drain on the track for Guerrero and it was put in the wrong place. The track was a 405 meter track and needs to be 400 meters (state certified). Northerly "D" zone needs to be realigned in order to make the track distance regulation.
- Todd and Bryan met with George Temple, Nafis & Young, Cape & Island and Guerrero to discuss who is at fault.
- First, Guerrero offered to pay 1/3 with Nafis & Young and the town. George said no. Guerrero offered to pay 50% with Nafis & Young.
- Guerrero will correct the problem and submit a claim to the town. The cost will be between \$23,000 - \$30,000.

Grandstand

- E & D will install additional bleachers at a cost of \$128,000. We can eliminate the handicap railings by expanding the bleachers to the top of the hill. Handicap seating will have access from the top. This will be a savings of \$72,0000. Completion is expected to be done by August 22, 2013.

Field Turf

- Field turf is complete except for minor damage to the driveway. We still have \$26,010 retainage.

Rubberized Track

- Cape & Island were on site but had to leave because of the drain error. They will return once repair is made by Guerrero. Expected return date is June 24, 2013.

Site Electrical

- Site Electric is requesting their retainage.

Earthworks

- Javeline is 65% done, shot-put is done, discus is on the field.
- There is a pathway to concessions.

Correspondence

- Todd read a letter from George Temple saying that all fundraiser requests to use the field need to go through the selectman's office.
