Re: Approval of Town of Oxford's Aquifer Protection Regulations

Dear Mr. Secor:

The Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) received the Town of Oxford's Aquifer Protection Area Regulations on November 6, 2007. Such regulations were adopted by the Oxford's Aquifer Protection Agency at a public hearing on July 19, 2007 in accordance with Connecticut General Statutes (CGS) Section 22a-354p and Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies (RCSA) Section 22a-354i-3.

The Department has reviewed the regulations and has determined that the regulations are consistent with the DEP's Aquifer Protection Area Regulations as required by CGS Section 22a-354p(f) and are hereby approved. The regulations shall now become effective on the date established by your Aquifer Protection Agency, provided such regulations shall be filed in the office of the town clerk.

As you are aware, Oxford's Aquifer Protection Area Regulations will need to be amended in the near future as a result of the October 1, 2007 amendments made to the Connecticut General Statues that affect the Aquifer Protection Area Program. The necessary changes to local regulations have been included in the DEP's Model Municipal Aquifer Protection Area Regulations, revised October 1, 2007.
