#### **Approve Minutes from Previous Meeting**

Sharon Morton made a motion to accept the minutes from the 2/7/13 meeting. Jim Wlasuk seconded the motion. All Aye. Motion carries.

### **Status of New Building**

Jeff Haney advised that the blasting behind the building has been completed and the placement of blocks is expected to begin on Friday, May 3. If the retaining wall exceeds 3 feet, then it will need to receive engineering approval. Gary Pellitier volunteered to help with the footings/walls/floor.

Plumbing volunteers are still needed. Jeff Haney will work on obtaining an estimate for the electrical work.

Jeff Haney also suggested that the kennel drain trough be purchased since this would be a time-consuming, difficult endeavor.

Water will need to be turned off to the shelter during certain portions of construction. A specialty hose will be needed to bring water for drinking from the fire house during those times that the water is turned off. Other alternatives including bringing in a water supply were discussed. A final solution will be determined at a later time.
