Discover the wonders of great art in a guided tour exploring the rich collections of America's oldest public art museum. Established in 1842 by Hartford art patron Daniel Wadsworth, the Wadsworth Atheneum Museum of Art houses an extensive permanent collection spanning 5,000 years of art history, complemented by an exceptional array of special exhibitions. Participants will experience the museum's Hudson River School landscapes, Old Master paintings, surrealist and modernist masterpieces, Meissen and Sevres porcelains, early American furniture and decorative arts, and Matric contemporary arts. The tour will also include a look at the special exhibition *American Moderns on Paper: Masterworks from the Wadsworth Atheneum*. This first time exhibition will give an in-depth examination of the Atheneum's finest American watercolors, pastels and drawings by artists including Georgia O'Keefe, Edward Hopper and Andrew Wyeth.

Make your museum visit more fun by "Learning to Look at Art". In this class you will gain the tools to understand what you are looking at when you view art including composition, color relationships, value and color density. Discover why some art has an impact on your emotions so that you love or hate it and why other art leaves you cold. Artist/Instructor Dorothy Peebles-Pelley will be your guide on this adventure into art both in the class and after the official tour the museum during the afternoon free time so that you can enjoy trying out your new skills.
