

**NOTICE TO THE TAXPAYERS  
OF OXFORD, CONNECTICUT  
Tax Collector's Notice**

Please be advised that taxes on the Grand List of October 1, 2015 will become due and payable July 1, 2016 for Real Estate, Personal Property, and Motor Vehicle.

Due dates are as follows;

Real Estate and Personal Property first installments due July 1, 2016-August 1, 2016  
Motor Vehicle (one installment only) due July 1, 2016-August 1, 2016.

Real Estate and Personal Property second installments due January 1, 2017-February 1, 2017.

\*\*\*Per CT General State Statute 12-146 interest will accrue at a rate of 1.5% monthly from the original due dates, on any late balance, as of August 2, 2016 or February 2, 2017 for late second installments. \*\*\* NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE

Importantly, it should be noted that failure to receive a tax bill does not invalidate the tax due nor any accrued interest there of (Per CT General State Statutes 12-130.)

**IMPORTANT NOTICE ABOUT YOUR MOTOR VEHICLE TAX BILLS**

CT DMV AND MUNICIPALITIES ACROSS THE STATE ARE WORKING TO RESOLVE SOME INCONSISTENCIES AMONG RESIDENTS' MAILING ADDRESSES AND DOMICILE (TOWN IN WHICH VEHICLE IS GARAGED) ADDRESSES.

IF YOU HAVE RECEIVED A TAX BILL FROM A TOWN THAT YOU DID NOT RESIDE IN  GARAGE YOUR VEHICLE IN AS OF OCTOBER 1, 2015, Contact the Tax Assessor to request a transfer to the correct Town/City of residency as of October 1, 2015.

WORKING TOGETHER TO CORRECT THESE DISCREPANCIES WILL HELP TO ELIMINATE OR AT LEAST DECREASE THE WAIT TIME AT THE DMV OFFICES.

IF YOUR REGISTRATION IS DUE TO EXPIRE WITHIN 60 DAYS (OR HAS ALREADY EXPIRED) AND YOU HAVE NOT RECEIVED A RENEWAL NOTIFICATION YOU MUST CONTACT THE DMV. IF YOU ARE BEING REPORTED WITH A TAX (OR OTHER) COMPLIANCE ISSUE IN A TOWN YOU NEVER LIVED IN, YOU SHOULD CONTACT THE TOWN REPORTING THE COMPLIANCE.

The Tax Collector's Office will be available to receive payments at the Oxford Town Hall; Monday 9am- 7pm and Tuesday- Friday 9am-5pm. (Summer hours: Friday 8am-4pm)

The Town of Oxford accepts Credit Card payments thru Point and Pay via our website: [www.oxford-ct.gov](http://www.oxford-ct.gov). This is an outside company; they will charge a convenience fee of 2.50%. \*\*Mastercard, Visa, Discover, and American Express are accepted\*\*.
