OXFORD, CONNECTICUT
Tax Collector's Notice

Please be advised that the Second Installment of Taxes on the Grand List of October 1, 2015 will become due and payable January, 1, 2017 for Real Estate, Personal Property and Motor Vehicle Supplemental Bills.

Due dates are as follows:

Real Estate and Personal Property Second installments due January 1, 2017. Last Day to Pay without penalty is February 1, 2017.

Motor Vehicle Supplemental Bills are due January 2, 2017 with the last day to pay being February 1, 2017. **Per CTGS 12-146 Interest will accrue at a rate of 1.5% monthly from the original due dates, on any late balance, as of February 1, 2017 for second installments. **** NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE.**** Importantly, it should be noted that failure to receive a tax bill does not invalidate the Tax due nor any accrued interest thereof (Per CT General State Statute 12-130.)

The Tax Office will be available to receive payments at the Oxford Town Hall, 486 Oxford Rd, Oxford, CT; Mondays 9am-7pm, except on December 26th and January 2nd and January 16th which are Holidays and Town Hall will be closed. However, the next day after the Holiday, Tuesday Dec.27th and Jan.3rd and 17th our hours will be 9am-7pm. Regular hours are Tuesdays through Thursdays from 9am-5pm. Until further notice, Friday hours are 8am-4pm.

The Town of Oxford accepts payment via Credit/Debit card. Please go to the Town of Oxford's website: oxford-ct.gov and follow the link to pay your taxes online. Also, you can view the Tax Amount Due on the Tax Collector's website. We are now using Point and Pay to process credit/debit payments. This is a private company and the service fee is 2.5% on amount due.

Payments may be mailed to: Town of Oxford-Tax Collector, 486 Oxford Rd., Oxford, CT 06478, or you may use the envelope provided to mail your payment to our Lock Box in MA. If you require a receipt, please include a self-addressed stamped envelope with your payment and bill.

*****ALTHOUGH IT IS YOUR RIGHT TO PAY ON THE LAST DAY (FEBRUARY 1, 2017) NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE FOR THE LAST DAY TO PAY. If paying by mail, please be sure to have your envelope postmarked February 1, 2017. *****

IMPORTANT NOTICE ABOUT YOUR MOTOR VEHICLE TAX BILLS

CT DMV AND MUNICIPALITIES ACROSS THE STATE ARE WORKING TO RESOLVE SOME INCONSISTENCIES AMONG RESIDENTS' MAILING ADDRESSES AND DOMICILE (TOWN IN WHICH VEHICLE IS GARAGED) ADDRESSES.

IF YOU HAVE RECEIVED A TAX BILL FROM A TOWN THAT YOU DID NOT RESIDE IN OR GARAGE YOUR VEHICLE IN AS OF OCTOBER 1, 2015, CONTACT THE ASSESSOR TO REQUEST A TRANSFER TO THE CORRECT TOWN/CITY OF RESIDENCY AS OF OCTOBER 1, 2015.

WORKING TOGETHER TO CORRECT THESE DISCREPANCIES WILL HELP TO ELIMINATE OR AT LEAST DECREASE THE WAIT TIME AT THE DMV OFFICES.

IF YOUR REGISTRATION IS DUE TO EXPIRE WITHIN 60 DAYS (OR HAS ALREADY EXPIRED) AND YOU HAVE NOT RECEIVED A RENEWAL NOTIFICATION YOU MUST CONTACT THE DMV. IF YOU ARE BEING REPORTED WITH A TAX (OR OTHER) COMPLIANCE ISSUE IN A TOWN YOU NEVER LIVED IN, YOU SHOULD CONTACT THE TOWN REPORTING THE COMPLIANCE.
