Manuel Silva P.E. (Project Manager, Rose-Tiso & Co. LLC), representing applicant (Oxford at Glendale, LLC)

Mr. Silva explained that the applicant is proposing to amend the existing approval of 42,300 GPD to 75,000 GPD. The applicant has land use approvals for the previous application and is the process of getting approvals for approximately 200 additional units.

Mr. Silva reviewed the drawings with the WPCA. Six inch PVC will come into the main lines with individual laterals. The line will be all gravity flow. Tie-in fees will be required for each individual unit.

The application from Glendale at Oxford LLC. Was accepted and the drawings will be sent to the Town Engineer for review. Applicant will pay review fee prior to approval.

2) Discussion on the request from the Planning & Zoning Commission for the WPCA to take action on Second Street Leasing LLC. The applicant is adding a service station to his existing business.

A letter will be sent to the Planning & Zoning recommending that the applicant up date their use and get their re- approval for the oil-water separator with the CT DEEP.

Report from Staff

1. Oxford Greens - The first phase of Phase 4 is almost completed.
2. Perkins Road pump station has had minor issues with the high demand on the power.
3. The sewer service maps do designate all the sewers. Copies will be provided.

Other Business

Discussion on the \$4,519.12 invoice, dated 7/12/12, from the Seymour WPCA. No response has been received from Kevin Condon, Town Attorney, regarding letter, dated 8/20/12, requesting his opinion on this matter. After reviewing the agreement with the Seymour WPCA, the members felt that the invoices did not fall under the agreement. A letter will be sent to the Seymour WPCA regarding the invoices.
