Children's Garden @ Great Oak School

- Due to the misinformed information reported by the Voices, Bob contacted the reporter and editor and cleared up the misunderstanding. The latest article in the November 16th 2014 edition of the Voices was discussed.

- At the Oxford BOE meeting at the High School held on December 9th, Agricultural Committee members and the Town Grant writer explained the current plans, including initial funding and providing a draft copy of the infrastructure development at the tennis courts behind the school. A discussion about curriculum was also included and supporters in the audience provided additional input for the children's garden. After the presentation the Board acknowledged its support for the children's garden but needed time to review the plans. The BOE asked if a school board representative could attend the Agricultural Committee meetings to maintain communication between the two groups and was advised that the Ag Committee meetings are open to the public.
