Meeting was called to order at 7:02

Members Present: Mr. Romagna, Mr. Rotzal, Mr. Shumitz, Ms. Kasuba, Ms. Sherman

Others Present: Ms. Robin Schreiber- Troop 1 Boy Scouts, Mr. Tony DeFazio.

New Business- Mr. Romagna reported that he attended the Board of Selectman meeting and advised of the denial of the GOMS uniform request and advised the Board of Selectman that 3 out of the 5 items we requested were not provided. He advised that we struggled with the charge to the committee. There was a discussion that the committee should not fund normal operating costs but projects or things that are outside of the day to day operation. Mr. Rotzal asked if a pool table room at the Senior Center would be applicable. Discussion was held that there would need to be discussion and checking with the town finance director to see if there was any budget for such items first.

Old Business- The only old business was the discussion above about the GOMS uniform request.

Audience of citizens- Ms. Schreiber attended the meeting to discuss options for funding from the committee. Several scenarios were discussed such as funding for Eagle Scout projects and Community planned events. Ms. Schreiber thanked the committee for allowing her to ask questions and it was very helpful attending the meeting.

Approval of minutes- Minutes were reviewed. Motion by Mr. Rotzal seconded by Ms. Kashuba to approve the minutes. Motion carries with Mr. Schumitz abstaining.

Review any applications- Three applications were received for review/approval.

Oxford High School Youth Conservations Corps:

The committee reviewed the application and has some questions about past funding through the town budget line from 2017 and about funding for wages. Motion by Mr. Rotzal seconded by Mr. Shumitz to table this application for additional information.

Oxford Soccer League:

The request is for equipment for the new Aggie soccer fields. The committee

reviewed and discussed the need for same, the openness of the usage to the committee and whether or not there were funds available from Park & Rec to pay for the equipment. Motion by Mr. Rotzal, seconded by Ms. Sherman to approve \$6,400 for the new goals with the provision that they will be open to public usage while not in use by the league.

Oxford Main Street Project:

The committee reviewed the application and discussed that there are a lot of questions about funding. Motion by Mr. Rotzal, seconded by Ms. Kashuba to table this for future discussions.

Adjourn:

Motion by Mr. Rotzal, seconded by Mr. Schumitz to adjourn. Meeting was adjourned at 8:32.
