REGULAR MEETING MINUTES

Tuesday, November 12, 2013

The **Regular Meeting** of the Oxford Conservation Commission/Inland Wetlands Agency was held in the Main Meeting Room of the S.B. Church Memorial Town Hall on Tuesday, November 12th, 2013.

Meeting was called to order at 7:37 P.M. by Chairman Michael Herde

NEW BUSINESS:

1) Oxford Housing Authority (IW 13-118) 8 units: Mr. Donald Smith Jr. (P.E. Engineer, Office in Seymour, Ct.) stated: I'm here representing Oxford Housing Authority and I submitted a plan last week to I.W.E. Officer A. Ferrillo and there was a question of whether or not to act

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on it administratively or whether we would have to be in front of the Commission and showed the current plan.

Chairman M. Herde stated: I wanted also to let the Commission know that I did speak with Andy on this last week and everything is a pretty significant distance from the wetland.

Mr. Donald Smith stated: Showed his map and pointed to areas. The southern entrance (main entrance to Oxford Senior Center) and the northern entrance on Stakum Circle which has 5 existing buildings and we are looking to add at corner of the existing Stakum Circle. The construction will be the same design as 3 out of the 5 buildings. There are no wetlands here on the site.

Chairman M. Herde asked about the drainage systems.

Mr. Smith replied: We have not gotten to that yet. We were just authorized to go ahead about a week ago and we hope to have the drainage system information by December. The plan you see before you is based on record drawings from the original design and asbuilt. As soon as we get the drainage calculations, we will get them to you.

Chairman M. Herde asked if anyone wanted to make a motion to refer this back to the Enforcement Officer.

MOTION made by Commissioner T. Adamski to refer Oxford Housing Authority (IW 13-118) back to the Enforcement Officer. **Seconded** by Commissioner B. Richter. All in favor 5-0

(IW 13-103) 556 Oxford Road, Oxford, CT. (Veterinary Hospital) Fred D'Amico (P.E. & owner of D'Amico Associates) stated: I received the drainage calculations that show 28 galleys. Nafis doesn't allow you to count for filtration and that is the change. Here are the revise drawings.

Chairman M. Herde asked if everyone was ok with this and if anyone had any comments.

MOTION made by Commissioner B. Richter to approve (IW 13-103) 556 Oxford Road, Oxford, CT. **Seconded** by Commissioner T. Adamksi. All in favor 5-0.

Mr. D'Amico stated that 130 Park Rd (Mr. Percoccini) who has just bought the property but they want to repair the wall leading to Swan Lake. Mr. D'Amico showed the Commission the A-2 survey map showing how the repair would be done. There are 2 existing walls, one that is close to the water and another one about 10 feet back. He plans to replace a portion of the front wall and then cut back to the other wall where it will be one wall.

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Chairman M. Herde stated and asked: We will need an approved as-built on the final wall to make sure it is in the right spot. What kind of wall is being built?

Mr. D'Amico replied: He is going to do a concrete block wall with the stamp on the outside.

Chairman M. Herde asked what kind of wall is it now.

Mr. D'Amico replied: Its cinder concrete block.

Chairman M. Herde asked if anyone had any objections here. Do we have an application on this?

Mr. D'Amico stated: We don't yet. I did speak with the Enforcement Officer on this but he was not sure if the Commission would just refer back to him and I don't yet know the fee. Mr. D'Amico gave the map to the Secretary.

Chairman M. Herde stated: I think we should just refer this back to Andy and have it handled administratively.

MOTION made by Commissioner T. Adamski refer 130 Park Road back to the Enforcement Officer for administrative handling. Seconded by Commissioner B. Richter. All in Favor 5-0

Chairman M. Herde asked the Commission about their opinion on walking the 10 Park Rd property.

Commissioner T. Adamski stated: I think the soil is going to go, let's get it out before it goes.

Commissioner S. Purcella Gibbons stated: Maybe do some wetland plantings to stabilize it.

Commissioner T. Adamski asked: How far would you have to back?

Mr. D'Amico replied: It's hard to say. He probably filled about 1 to 1.5 feet and then slopes down to zero. He didn't actually make the brook smaller but he did fill in a flood plain.

Chairman M. Herde stated that we should work on a cease and restore order.

Chairman M. Herde replied: I would assume so.

Mr. Ligi asked: Do I have to come back to another meeting?

Chairman M. Herde replied: By then you will find out and the Town Engineer will find out about this. I will touch base with the Wetlands Officer and let you know what is going on. I will make sure someone gets back to you.

Mr. Ligi thanked the Commission and left the room.
