Special Meeting AND Site Inspections April 11, 2018

The Special Meeting of the Oxford Safety & Health Committee (OSHC) was called to order at 2:00 PM en route to Posypanko Park.

The following members were present: Chairman Kelly Weymer, Vice-Chairman Margaret West-Mainor, Gordon Gramolini and Sharon Trede.

Matters As Deemed Necessary

- * Chairman Weymer explained that a letter was sent to the Administration stating our concerns as discussed at the 2/14/18 OSHC meeting. The following items were discussed:
- Armed & Ready re-installed the Panic Button in the Tax Collector's office and the invoice was forwarded to this committee for payment.

<u>MOTION</u> was made by Margaret West-Mainor to approve to pay the Armed & Ready invoice. This was seconded by Gordon Gramolini. All were in favor. Chairman Weymer will sign and submit the invoice.

- Chairman Weymer explained that a new, fully stocked First Aid Kit was installed in the Employee's Lounge at Town Hall. The Administration is requesting the funds come from this committee.

MOTION was made by Margaret West-Mainor to approve to pay the invoice for the new First Aid Kit. This was seconded by Sharon Trede. All were in favor. Chairman Weymer will sign and submit the invoice once it is received.

- Chairman Weymer explained that the shrubs in the driveway should be addressed soon as it is now Spring. If they are not cut back by our next meeting, a letter will be re-sent requesting they are.
- Chairman Weymer stated that the new Administrative Assistant had just recently attended a Sexual Harassment Seminar. Again, if a seminar for both Sexual Harassment and Workplace Bullying are not scheduled for ALL employees by our next meeting, a letter will be re-sent requesting they are.
- * As far as the dangerous middle door of the Main Meeting Room, it was suggested that panic hardware be placed on this door as it opens into the hallway only a few inches from the middle automatic sliding glass door. The committee suggests that the other two doors could be equipped with handicap handles.
- * Chairman Weymer informed the committee that a Safety and Health Committee Audit was conducted by the State of Connecticut Workers' Compensation Commission on 12/6/17. The Connecticut General Statutes require the establishment of a safety and health committee with a minimum of quarterly meetings. A letter was received on 2/26/18 determining that Oxford is indeed in compliance with the safety and health regulations (Attachment C). Chairman Weymer praised the committee for their dedication, support, volunteerism and their patience. It is through our members that we try to help make our workplaces safer for all employees.
