OLD BUSINESS

1. Update on 501(c)(3)

Vice Chairman Tony SanAngelo stated that he spoke with executives at Stihl Corporation, who indicated that they would like to offer a donation to OMSP of labor-in-kind. Stihl was also asked if they would be willing to make a financial contribution. Approval would need to come from the headquarters in VA. Discussion ensued concerning additional corporation board members, quarterly accounting, fundraising and additional monetary contributions.

2. Update on ORIC money

The process for obtaining money from ORIC was discussed. Melissa Wall, former ORIC chair, will need to complete forms to the State.

3. Path along the river

Bryan Nesteriak was to stake out the trail. This should happen soon. Fallen trees will be removed in the spring. Sponsors are needed for bridges and walkways. Step 1 is to get the nature preserve operational; Step 2 is to obtain the routing study and begin the walkways down Rt. 67. The routing study is currently in progress and will be ready in a year. This will give time to solidify the corporation, have volunteers in place and present fundraising events.


