1. Grant Project updates:
 - Spending deadlines: STR- by May, Fiscal Year 2019 LPC-by June 30th, SOR-by September 1st, Fiscal Year 2020 LPC- By June 30th 2020
 - a. Mass mailing: some response from first mailing including three new folks present for LPC. Vinny would like to do another mass mailing for the vaping program
 - i. Could we bring information and have a presence at school sporting events, or town rec sports
 - b. Community of Concern: program is unreachable, so funding of \$2125 from LPC will need to be reallocated
 - i. HIPS (Hidden in Plain Sight) – for parents to learn how to recognize drug use in their home and children. About \$500 for the event, could be connected to the open house for back to school. Will plan for October, Jen DeWitt will contact trainers in the area.
 - ii. Some money spent on materials and quality handouts to be distributed at back to school. Including "Vaping: what you need to know and how to talk to your kids" to be downloaded and 1,000 copies printed at Staples. Sheniequa will get these done.

- iii. NA & AA pamphlets to be put in public library and possibly the school libraries.
 - c. Those Who Host Campaign:
 - d. Rob Hackenson's Dynamic Influence (Vaping) program: \$2100 for four events (2 at high school, 1 at middle school, and 1 evening program)
 - e. Disposable Drug Bags:
 - f. SOR: Needs to be opioid specific to use grant money from SOR. \$5000 is left to spend on this grant

 3. HVCASA Update: Event went well, while not exceptional attendance there were good connections made and folks got a lot of information out of it. It did not seem to reach those who needed or had not yet heard this information. Audience was not the target audience.
