- 1. Grant Project updates:
- Spending deadlines: STR- by May, Fiscal Year 2019 LPC-by June 30th, SOR-by September 1st, Fiscal Year 2020 LPC- By June 30th 2020
 - Mass mailing: some response from first mailing including three new folks present for LPC. Vinny would like to do another mass mailing for the vaping program
 - Could we bring information and have a presence at school sporting events, or town rec sports
