 - c. "Like" movie for the Booster club - \$900 topics covered are vaping & social media. No official date set for this yet, temporarily set for springtime
 - d. HIPS program - \$500 Diane will check with the school to the best night for parents being at school. Stephanie suggested having a fall session for freshman/sophomore and a spring session for junior/senior. Laura suggested aiming for "meet the teacher" night
 - e. Steve is still looking into movie "Tough Guy" specifically for boys/men on violence - \$600 for an organizational license with unlimited use.
 - e.i. We will invite key educational leaders to a movie screening night. A \$50 7-day streaming license
