Scott Pelletier moved, seconded:

ITEM 1 Shall the Town of Oxford approve funding in the amount of \$23,403.00, to be taken from Capital and Non-Recurring, for the Homeland Security Mezzanine Project as approved by the Board of Selectmen on 5/4/16 and the Board of Finance on 5/23/16?

First Selectman Temple explained that he has wanted to do this for 3 years now after discussion with our Fire Chief and Public works director. The town has to keep over 14,000 MRE's for emergency preparedness. This Mezzanine will provide the climate control necessary for the food as well as the radio equipment. He then thanked Scott for getting this done. There being no other comments or questions the moderator called for a vote.


Motion Carried: Unanimous
