First Selectman George Temple explained that this was the Sand and Gravel fund from Jackson's Cove which is used for this purpose. There being no other comments or questions the Moderator called for a vote.

Shall the Town of Oxford approve an appropriation in the amount of \$15,000.00 to be taken from the General Fund Balance, for the Water Pollution Control Authority's sewer construction inspection fees; as approved by the Board of Selectmen on 3/21/18 and Board of Finance on 4/5/18?


There being no comments or questions the moderator called for a vote.
