#### **OLD BUSINESS**

##### **RT 67 Sewer Line**

Before a full CO is given the following must be done:

As built drawing of the new line must be received and approved by WPCA.

Restoration from manhole 13 to manhole 33 (including, but not limited to)

- Remove all trees and brush that have been cut or damaged.

- Remove temporary pavement and install permanent pavement.

- Install erosion control along shoulder, manhole 13 to 24 and 30 to 33.

- Restoration needs to be approved by DOT & wetlands prior to WPCA approval.

The DOT will be working in the State right of way at Brookside Restaurant. They asked to delay paving.

On 7/26/2016 Scott and Mike Herde, Chairman of the OCCIWA, inspected the wetland areas along RT 67. He asked for various erosion control measures. The DOT said that in the state right of way they do not want the trees replaced. The DOT has a \$750,000 bond to cover the state right of way.

##### **E Commerce Sewer Line**

Sewer line is completed. All the utilizes have been installed and the road is being paved. As built has not been submitted. On site lateral will be installed. The Town will have to install a pump station once the lots are sold and developed.

Odor Complaint

No complaints over the last month.

Reviewed quotes for odor eliminators. Anything used has to be manually put into the system. Naugatuck is aware that action is being taken to resolve this issue.

Towner Lane Force Main Corrosion

A request for \$75,000 for corrosion evaluation will be made to the Boards of Selectmen and Finance.

Construction Standards

Reviewed the precast manhole detail. The flared manhole will be 36 inches on the inside. The final detail, with all modifications, will be reviewed at the next meeting.

The Board of Selectmen will be asked not to release the bond on Commerce Drive until it is completed to WPCA's satisfaction.


