# Northeast Stihl, Patriot Way

Siyuaa Cao, EIT, of Civil 1, representing the applicant, reviewed the drawings and application.

The proposed 300,00 s/f building will merge the two rear lots. It will be constructed in three phases. The office will be 10,500 s/f. There will be approximately 100 employees in the building.

There will be one pump chamber and a 2" pvc force main will be utilized. The estimated average GPD is 2,000. The dual granite pump, which can support 3,000 GPD will be used.

The applicant received previous approval (April 2014) for 21,000 GPD. This proposal is for less than 20% of that amount.

Scott Halstead noted that the sewer line on Patriot Way to the high point. The gravity line and force main have not been tested.

**MOTION** by Larry Ellis to approve Northeast Stihl, Inc, Patriot Way, assessor's (Map 18, Block 20, Lot 12, 15B & 16), with the understanding that the force main section of this approval is owned by property owner and contingent upon the completion and approval of the gravity line and that all appropriate fees be paid. Second by Bob Peck. Motion unanimously approved.
